A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE INTERIM
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF OSCEOLA FOR FIRE
PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS, Penn Township has been providing fire protection and emergency services to the Town of Osceola due to the Town of Osceola ceasing to operate its fire department and being unable to respond to calls for services;

WHEREAS, Penn Township requires payment for such services and the Town of Osceola wishes to pay Penn Township for fire protection and emergency services provided on a temporary basis until December 31, 2017 pursuant to an Interim Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Osceola, attached hereto as Exhibit "A; and

WHEREAS, Penn Township and the Town of Osceola are currently in negotiations for a long-term contract for fire protection and emergency services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Penn Township, St. Joseph County, Indiana hereby approves the adoption of an Interim Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Osceola for Fire Protection and Emergency Services.
