

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE PENN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF PENN TOWNSHIP, INDIANA,
REVISE THE "FIRE RECOVERY FUND" NON-REVERTING FUND

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Board, Penn Township Indiana, is the legislative and fiscal body of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, The Penn Township Fire Department provides fire, rescue, inspection and pre-plan services for the citizens of Penn Township; and

WHEREAS, the services provided are an integral part of maintaining an effective and skilled fire department and for the safety of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township receives funds from Fire Recovery USA and now through the efforts of Peters Municipal Consultants, Ltd.

WHEREAS, funds received from Fire Recovery USA and through the efforts of Peters Municipal Consultants, Ltd., shall not revert to the Fire Departments general fund if not expended by the end of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED by the Penn Township Board of Penn Township, Indiana.

SECTION I.

There is created in Penn Township, a non-reverting fund called Fire Recovery Fund subject to the following terms and conditions:

A. The source of funds which are to be deposited into said Fire Recovery Fund shall be monies received from Fire Recovery USA and now through the efforts of Peters Municipal Consultants, Ltd.

B. Said fund shall be used for the following:

Wear and tear on Equipment (Fire apparatus)	Budget line (II-BC)
Wear and tear on Personal Protective Equipment	Budget line (II-AC)
Wear and Tear on Equipment (Hose) (Nozzles) etc.	Budget line (II-BA)
Materials used on spills (to absorb spilled fluids)	Budget line (II-AE)
Fuel	Budget line (II-AF)

C. Said fund may be used as a source for loans to other Firefighting funds.


D. Said fund shall be maintained by the Penn Township Trustee's Office and the rules for proper accounting and expenditures of monies received and deposited into said Fire Recovery Fund shall be those established by the State Board of Accounts.

SECTION II.


This Resolution shall take effect and be in force March 1, 2016 and passed by the Penn Township Board on the 14th day of March 2016.
