

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 –10

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF PENN TOWNSHIP, ST. JOSEPH COUNTY, INDIANA DECLARING INTENTION NOT TO DEFER PAYROLL TAXES

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has issued an Executive Order allowing Employers to defer the payroll tax withholdings of Employees from September 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, in the event that this option were chosen, each Employee would then have double withholdings taken out of paychecks starting January 1, 2021 in order to pay the amount due to the Internal Revenue Service for those deferred taxes.

WHEREAS, all employees of the Township and Fire Territory have been paid during the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHEREAS, the liability for un-withheld taxes during 2020 for an Employee that leaves the Township or Fire Territory becomes the responsibility of the employer.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of Penn Township, St. Joseph County, Indiana, as follow:

SECTION 1. The Penn Township Board is declaring that is will not be deferring payroll tax withholdings for any Employees of the Township or the Fire Territory.

SECTION 2. Payroll taxes will continue to be withheld at current levels in order to protect employees from double taxation in 2021.
